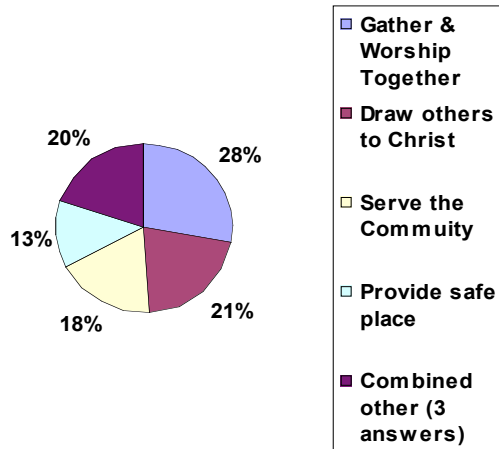

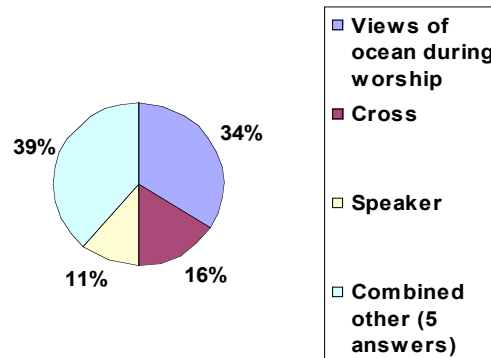

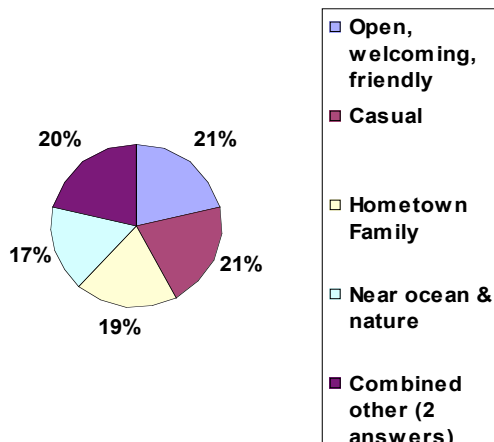
Primary purpose of our campus



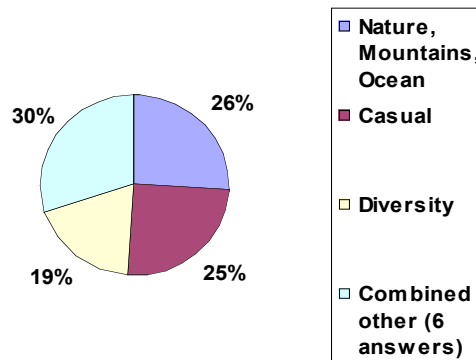
Primary visual focus during worship



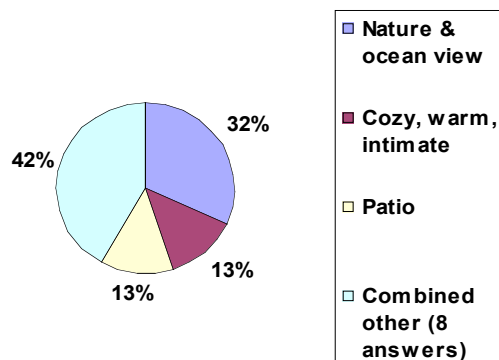
Unique characteristic of our Church



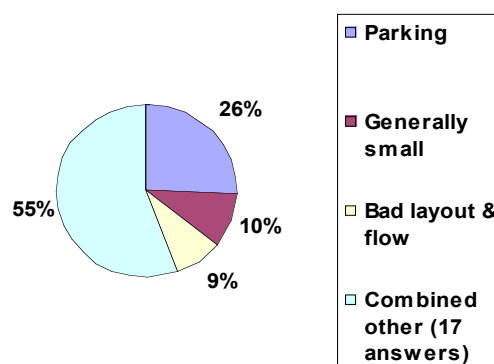
Unique characteristic of our community



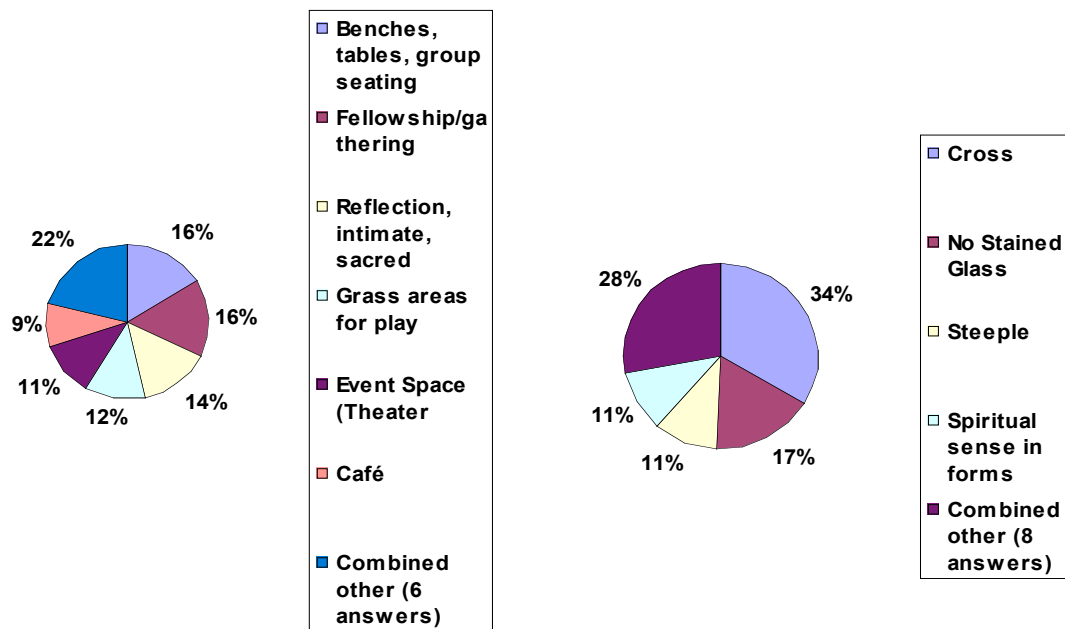
Liked BEST about previous campus

WHERE ARE WE NOW???

We are awaiting Session approval of a final budget number to give to the architects so they can initiate the formal design phase.

In May/June, the BRC worked to reconcile the current design by Dominy and Associates with the original budget of \$12mm established by Session. The committee solicited line item cost projections (room by room) from several construction companies and quickly realized the established budget was not realistic based on the plans we had in store for ministries, programs and growth. Solving the parking problem alone entails building a parking structure costing roughly \$3.4mm! As we tried to make line item cuts we came to the realization that with a \$12mm budget we would either need to build in phases OR significantly reduce the overall scope and size of the project. The BRC will continue to focus in the months ahead on possible solutions which would allow our church to continue to serve the needs of our congregation, community and His kingdom well into the future. The committee is working closely with Session to determine the solution which best fits the vision and mission of MPC with the financial resources available to us.

Concurrently, members of MPC are working on further refining the funds which may be available to the church. In the coming months, it is anticipated we will negotiate a settlement amount with the insurance company for the replacement of our church. With a firm number in hand, both the BRC and Session will be prepared to make final decisions regarding the master plan for developing our new church campus.

Once the first phase of design is complete, MPC will submit an application for the necessary permits, and we will await decisions from the City of Malibu as to when we can start building our new church.

Please continue to pray for this entire rebuilding process as we move forward in this exciting endeavor in the life of our Church. We desperately need God's direction and blessings for this to

work. Additionally, there is a prayer meeting on the site every Wednesday morning at 7:00 A.M. We pray for the site, for the plans, for the City and for the church. Please join us!
